

Perth Spectres COVID-19 Policy

Our Approach

1. The Spectres approach to managing COVID-19 is guided by our values which are respect, friendship and community.
2. We are a people focused club and we will promote and ensure the risks associated with COVID-19 are effectively managed.
3. We will implement Government mandates relating to COVID-19. We expect members and visitors to do the same.
4. We will look out for one another at our train and play sessions, competition games, events and within the club; recognising our physical, mental and social health and safety is very important.
5. We ask that if anyone attending a Spectres event has any particular concerns relating to COVID-19 to please let a Committee member know, so we can ensure your needs are managed while attending our event.

Wearing of Masks

1. Should it be required by the WA Government, all people present at a Spectres game or event are to wear masks which cover their mouth and nose, unless exempt.
2. The WA Government may at times permit masks to be removed during strenuous or vigorous physical activity. If this is the case, masks are to be put back on immediately after engaging in strenuous physical activity. This includes while listening to coaching guidance, scoring and while having a rest. Coaches are permitted to remove their mask while providing instruction.
3. Players are welcome to wear masks above and beyond what is required by a government mandate. If you do, we recommend taking regular breaks as basketball can be quite vigorous at times.

Vaccinations

1. We strongly advocate for our members and visitors to be double vaccinated and boosted when attending our events. This is an extra step you can take to respect the health and safety of our community.
2. We will abide by WA Government vaccinate mandates.
3. We will abide by the policies of venues where we play and have events.
4. Should proof of vaccination apply to venues where Spectres games and events are held, we request you provide this information in accordance with Government requirements when checking in to the venue.

COVID-19 Infection Management

1. We ask everyone to maintain good hand and respiratory hygiene at all times.
2. We will ensure equipment is regularly cleaned and sanitised to minimise cross contamination.
3. In order to ensure effective contact tracing, members and visitors are to check-in at the entrance to the venue and register your information with the Club when asked.
4. Should you contract COVID-19 and be present at a Spectres event prior to the onset of symptoms and subsequent positive test, please let a Committee know immediately. This will enable the Club to assist with contact tracing and put cleaning and sanitising measures in place.
5. Should you contract COVID-19 and/or be identified as a close contact or casual contact, it is requested you follow the advice of the WA Government and not attend any Spectres events until permitted to do so by the Government.
6. If you have cold and flu-like symptoms, we ask you to stay at home unless you have obtained a recent negative COVID-19 test result.
7. If you are required to isolate, please feel free to contact our Club. Our members will do the best we can to help you out.
